Three Tiered Doll Skirt

Whether you use three different colors or two or just one, this little skirt is lots of fun! Quick, easy pattern that's great for beginning knitters.

Materials: US6 dpns, 16" circular, 1-1.5 ozs worsted weight yarn.

Two sizes—small fits 10" dolls, large fits 16" dolls (this pattern was based on measurements of 10" dolls like Puddlefoot Dolls and Bamboletta Little Buddies and 15-16" dolls like Bamboletta. You can easily modify the length to fit your doll by subtracting a row or two in each tier.)

Gauge: 5 spi. Finished length 3.5" (4.25")

Cast on 40 (52)

Join in the round and knit 2 x 2 ribbing for 4 (6) rows

Knit in st st for 6 (8) rows

Change yarn color, *knit 2, yo* that row

Knit in st st for 6 (8) rows

Change yarn color, *knit 2, yo* that row

Knit in st st for 6 (8) rows

Work garter hem: purl row, knit row, purl row.

Bind off knitwise. Weave in ends. Make a single-crochet or braided drawstring.

To emphasize a ruffled skirt, when you wash and block it, "flute" the skirt like a pie crust.
